 Follow the prompts to register/sign-in and to request a transcript. Be sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript." DO NOT REQUEST THE "IRS Tax Account Transcript." The copy can be submitted to our office via an encrypted emailed, faxed or mailed to our office.
- Call the IRS at 1-800-908-9946 to request a tax transcript.
