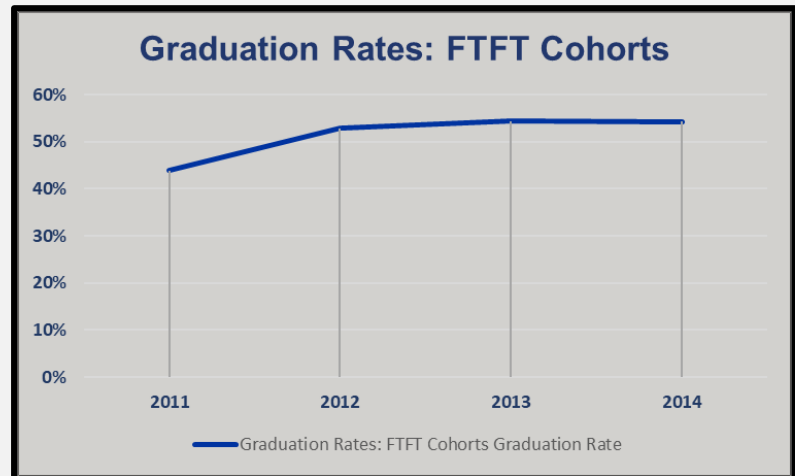


Institutional Graduation Rates

First-Time, Full-Time Undergraduate Cohorts

Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion:
