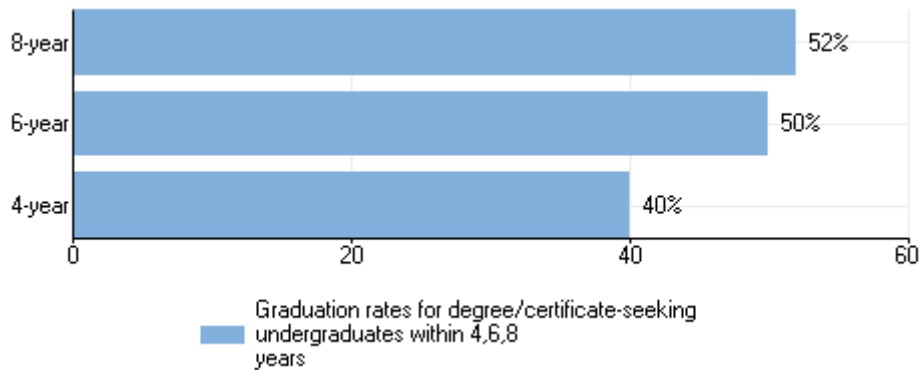


# Institutional Graduation Rates
