We want you to be aware of the values and standards of the OneLife Institute. Please take time to prayerfully consider the following and evaluate whether or not these values are standards you are willing to commit to during the time you are a OneLife student.

- 1. We understand the power of distractions and desire for this year to be an intense time of self-evaluation and growth. Your access to electronic technology such as cell phones, computers, iPods, and Internet-enabled devices will be significantly limited throughout the duration of the program. OneLife is not anti-technology but strives to be pro-community. We believe that fostering healthy community life and inter-personal relationships are an essential catalyst for spiritual growth.
- 2. Students are not permitted to engage in dating relationships with fellow OneLife students or SWU students during the 9 months of the program. We are not anti-dating, but, once again, we are pro-community. Our desire is to create healthy boundaries where students can focus on their relationship with God and grow in Christ-like character.
- 3. We believe in placing ourselves in uncomfortable situations in order to gain opportunities to grow and learn. You will be stretched this year.
- 4. There will be very limited "idle time" as we will be striving to take every opportunity to develop your skills and discover how to use them in the world. Weekdays and weekends alike are often scheduled with service opportunities and/or travel. The expectation is that you will be "all in" for all activities.
