Digital Mobile Mammography

Our Mobile Mammography Coach is equipped with a Hologic Selenia 2D/3D Full Field Digital Mammography Unit. The Mobile Mammography Coach is an extension of the Pearlie Harris Center for Breast Health, which is accredited by the American College of Radiology as a "Breast Imaging Center of Excellence". Each staff member is registered by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists and the South Carolina Radiation Quality Standards Association.

Our Services

The St. Francis Mobile Mammography Coach will provide screening mammograms to women throughout the community. A Screening Mammogram is a routine exam that is performed when you are not experiencing any problems and don't have any concerns with your breasts.

We will not be able to perform your exam if you are experiencing problems with your breasts such as a new lump, unusual nipple discharge and/or pain. We strongly recommend you contact your physician for an evaluation.

Eligibility...

- Females age 40 and older who are due for their annual screening mammogram

Patients call 675-4875 to schedule their appointment. They must tell the scheduler that they want to schedule on the Mobile Coach at the location desired (your site).

Mobile Coach Requirements:

The mobile coach is 40 feet long and weighs more than 26,000 pounds. To ensure we can safely provide our services a site visit may be performed prior to your screening date. The following physical criteria must be met:

- 1. Eleven reserved level parking spaces, preferably by a curb near the entrance of the site. Paved parking is required
- 2. A minimum overhead clearance of 14 feet. No low-lying trees blocking entrance or exit passages.
- 3. No sharp or narrow turns getting into or out of the parking area.
- 4. Close access to restroom facilities for staff and patients. There is no restroom on the bus.





As the representative, for The SWU Women's Conference I agree to the following terms and conditions for the Mobile Mammography Screening Services provided.

- 1. A minimum of 15 patients must be scheduled 10 business days prior to the screening date.
- 2. The host site may terminate this agreement by providing written notice up to two weeks prior to scheduled visit date.
- 3. Bon Secours St. Francis may terminate this agreement without cause prior to the scheduled visit date.
- 4. Our mobile mammography coach follows the Greenville County School closings for inclement weather. It will not operate while Code T-1 or Code T-2 are in effect.

Tornado Watch/Code T-1: If notified of T-1condition, the driver will, if possible, evacuate the mobile without endangering staff and patients to a safe shelter. **Tornado Warning/Code T-2**: If notified of T-2 condition, the driver will pull over to the side of the road, evacuate the mobile, and seek shelter in a safe place or in a ditch away from the vehicle until the storm passes. If patients are being screened, the mobile will be evacuated to a safe shelter or ditch until the storm passes.
