ONLINE PROGRAM

Employment of human and social service workers is expected to grow much faster than average through the year 2022 - this field is among the most rapidly growing occupations. Job opportunities for social and human service workers are expected to be excellent, particularly for applicants with appropriate education (from the Occupational Outlook Handbook - U.S. Department of Labor Statistics). Increasingly, postsecondary education or even postgraduate education (e.g., a Master's degree) is required to remain competitive in the field of social and human services.

In light of these trends, the Bachelor of Science in Human Services at SWU provides a broad-based program in human services that is based upon a Christian worldview and seeks to both provide students with basic skills in the human services field and to prepare students for more advanced work within the social science if desired. The program offers a variety of courses and opportunities designed to provide students with an understanding of the history of, and perspectives on human services and a solid background of skills and knowledge applicable to the field.

ONLINE EXPERIENCE

This program is offered in a fully online format, with all courses offered through an online learning management system. Courses are seven weeks in length.

As an online student, you will earn the same degree as you would in the physical classroom. Courses are taught in a flexible virtual classroom experience, designed to be both engaging and challenging. Students have access to an incredible array of learning resources and can complete their online degrees around their own schedule.
