ONLINE PROGRAM

If you want to increase your salary, expand your employability and advance your career ethically in the primary and secondary education worlds, a Master of Education in Administration & Supervision (MEDAS) degree can help make that happen. SWU's nationally recognized MEDAS degree program offers convenient on-site courses at five centralized campuses so teachers can work around their busy schedules.

Students will complete three practicum opportunities and an internship at their current school, gaining a deeper understanding of educational leadership, school operations management, community relations and advanced educational research. This program leads to advanced certification and, for those who have already earned a master's degree, will qualify you for SC's Masters Plus 30 status.

SWU's Master of Education degree program stands apart because it also incorporates Christ-centered strategies for handling the ethical and legal challenges of today's workplace.

Southern Wesleyan does not advise students on what will or will not be accepted by their state departments of education. Students are encouraged to contact their state department of education to ensure the degree offered by Southern Wesleyan University meets state requirements.

ONLINE EXPERIENCE

This program is offered in a fully online format, with all courses offered through an online learning management system. Courses are seven weeks in length.

As an online student, you will earn the same degree as you would in the physical classroom. Courses are taught in a flexible virtual classroom experience, designed to be both engaging and challenging. Students have access to an incredible array of learning resources and can complete their online degrees around their own schedule.
