

Southern Wesleyan University is proud to accept all ADN Associate Nursing degrees (or comparable) under the Partnership Agreement between South Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities (SCICU) and the SC Technical College System.

To be eligible for admission:

- Submission of completed application.
- Earned an Associate Degree in Nursing with at least 60 transferable credit hours from a regionally accredited college or university.
- Provide proof of current, unencumbered RN Licensure (USA). License must be active for duration of the student's enrollment.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 from all colleges and universities attended.
- Submit Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.

Under this partnership agreement, SC Technical College System nursing graduates interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) at Southern Wesleyan University will:

- Complete a mission-based, service-oriented capstone project;
- Participate in mentor-guided practicum and practical application experiences in lieu of standardized clinical assignments;
- Be admitted into the Southern Wesleyan University BSN program with junior standing;
- Be granted a waiver for the application for admission fee of \$25;
- Be granted a waiver for the computer competency challenge exam fee if student elects to take the challenge exam;
- Complete any outstanding Core Curriculum course requirements upon transfer;
- Complete the following courses: RELG 2403 Basic Christian Beliefs; BIBL 1013 Old Testament Survey; and BIBL 1023 New Testament Survey.

The baccalaureate degree program in nursing at Southern Wesleyan University is pursuing initial accreditation by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (http://www.ccneaccreditation.org). Applying for accreditation does not quarantee that accreditation will be granted.

If a candidate's GPA is below 2.75, the student may be admitted on a conditional basis, on the recommendation of the Undergraduate Admissions Committee.

Challenge exam is \$80 and can be taken if the student must complete the course CPSC 1103 Intro to Computers as a Core Curriculum requirement. Passing the challenge exam will exempt the student from taking the course.

Common outstanding requirements for ADN graduates upon transfer are courses in the following academic disciplines: fine arts; history; speech; and college-level math.
